



HRH PRINCESS ASTRID OF BELGIUM

REPRESENTATIVE OF HIS MAJESTY THE KING

Her Royal Highness Princess Astrid, Princess of Belgium, was born in Brussels on 5 June 1962. She is the second child of King Albert II and Queen Paola.

After her secondary education in Brussels, Princess Astrid studied art history for a year at Leiden in the Netherlands. She completed her education in Geneva, at the Institute of European Studies and in Michigan in the United States.

In Brussels on 22 September 1984, Princess Astrid married Lorenz, Archduke of Austria-Este, who became Prince of Belgium in 1995.

The couple have five children, all born in Belgium: Amedeo (21 February 1986), Maria Laura (26 August 1988), Joachim (9 December 1991), Luisa Maria (11 October 1995) and Laetitia Maria (23 April 2003).

Princess Astrid has always shown particular concern for those in society who risk falling through the net. She supports initiatives that assist the disadvantaged, in particular single

mothers and people lacking in education and skills.

In late June 2009, the International Paralympic Committee (IPC) Governing Board ratified the appointment of Princess Astrid as a member of the IPC Honorary Board.

In January 2010, the charity Action Damien/ Damiaanactie announced that Princess Astrid had agreed to take over from HM Queen Fabiola as Honorary President of the organization.

As Honorary President of the Queen Elisabeth Medical Foundation (QEMF) and the King Baudouin Foundation's Scientific and Medical Funds, Princess Astrid lends her support to fundamental medical research. She is involved in the fight against epidemics and pandemics, including from 2007 until 2015 as Special Representative of the Roll Back Malaria (RBM) Partnership. The Princess is also committed to championing the victims of violence, most notably in efforts to combat antipersonnel mines.

On 20 June 2013, the Secretariat of the Ottawa Anti-Personnel Mine Ban Convention announced that Princess Astrid - as Special Envoy of the Convention - would be part of a working group tasked with promoting the treaty at a diplomatic level in states that had not yet joined.

Princess Astrid joined the Belgian Armed Forces on 22 May 1997. She is a colonel in the Medical Unit.

The Princess is involved in the public activities of the Royal Family.

Princess Astrid represented the King at his request during the trade missions to Angola & South Africa and to India in 2013, to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia & the Sultanate of Oman, to Colombia & Peru and to Malaysia & Singapore in 2014, to Qatar & the United Arab Emirates and to Western Canada in 2015 and to Indonesia in 2016.

POLITICAL CAREER

Starting out his professional career as a lawyer and solicitor, Geert Bourgeois first acceded to politics in 1977, after having spent more than ten years at the service of the 'Vlaamse Beweging' (Flemish movement). He was first elected local councillor for the Volksunie party in Izegem before moving on to become alderman in this town. In 1995, he entered the Belgian House of Representatives, where he distinguished himself as a legal specialist.

In 2000 he came at the helm of the Volksunie. After the break-up of this party, he founded the Nieuw-Vlaamse Alliantie (N-VA) in 2001 and became the party's first leader.

Geert Bourgeois is Minister-President of the Government of Flanders, in which he is also competent for foreign policy and immovable heritage.

Geert has been a minister in the Government of Flanders since 2004. Over the years, his portfolio has included local and provincial government, public governance, foreign policy, civic integration, media, tourism, immovable heritage and the 'Vlaamse Rand' (ring of Flemish municipalities around the capital Brussels). In 2009, he became Vice-Minister-President. He has been Minister-president of the Government of Flanders since 2014.



The port of Ghent is a congestion-free logistical and industrial seaport specializing in the handling and storage of dry, liquid and agribulk, automotive and distribution. Typical commodities are agricultural products, vegetable oils, fertilizers, biomass, steel, coal, ores, construction materials, forest products, chemical and petroleum products, cars and trucks with 300 companies active.

And now, it's time for a new adventure.

The next step is a start-up in Houston, Texas, where we want to introduce our Belgian style forging in the American houses. We're still looking for (interior) architects, design shops, construction companies, roofers...



CITY OF BASTOGNE

Bastogne, a city full of memories

Bastogne is an important historical tourism destination home to many monuments and museums dedicated to the Battle of the Bulge, a key World War II battle.

Located in the center of the province of Luxembourg, close to the Luxembourg border, the city has always been a town that people passed through for trade, first for the nomadic peoples and then for the Romans.

But Bastogne owes its fame to one of the last German Offensives during World war II, better known as the Battle of the Bulge.

On main square, the "Sherman" tank and the statue of General McAuliffe are reminders of the Ardennes resistance during the Battle of the Bulge. On the Mardasson hill, a new place of remembrance dedicated to the Second World War, the Bastogne War Museum, opened in 2014.

Next to the museum lies the Mardasson Memorial. This gigantic star-shaped construction is a tribute from the Belgian people to the American forces who liberated the area during the Battle of the Bulge. As for sports fans, many may already know that the oldest road cycling race still running today, "Liège-Bastogne-Liège" passes through the town.



ECONOMIC PROFILE OF BELGIUM, THE HEART OF EUROPE

Belgium is a Federal Kingdom comprised of three Regions (the Flemish Region, the Walloon Region and the Brussels-Capital Region) and three Communities (the Flemish, the French and the German Communities).

Belgium has a population of 11.3 million inhabitants (2015 est.) and is one of the most densely populated countries in Europe. Brussels is the 'Capital of Europe': it hosts the headquarters of the European Commission, the Council of Ministers and the European Parliament. Other major international organizations, such as NATO, are also located in Belgium's capital. That is how Brussels ranks as the world's number three city (after London and Washington, D.C.) in terms of the number of accredited journalists and fourth in terms of the number of international meetings and seminars held.

With a surface of 30,500 km², Belgium is one of the smallest member states of the European Union. Nevertheless, it is a significant player in the world economy. Belgium scores particularly well for its export-driven economy and investment attractiveness. Its small size and limited internal market are the main factors behind the strong export culture in Belgium. Moreover, due to its well-developed infrastructure, good living standards, central location and highly-skilled workforce, Belgium is also praised by foreign investors.

GDP (Gross Domestic Product) reached €400.6 billion in 2014

and €409.8 billion in 2015. Despite the continuing financial and economic turmoil in Europe, Belgium's GDP kept increasing in both 2014 (+1.3%) and 2015 (+1.4%) (Source: National Bank of Belgium). Belgium also remains a high income country, with a GDP per capita of \$44.287 in 2015 (Source: OECD).

Belgium ranked 3rd on the annual KOF Index of Globalization in 2015, after being second a year earlier. This index measures the economic, social and political dimensions of globalization.

According to the World Trade Organization (WTO), Belgium was the 12^{th} exporter and 14^{th} importer of goods worldwide in 2015 with a share of 2.4% and 2.2% respectively. Belgium's own goods market is characterized by high levels of competition and an environment that facilitates new business creation. Business operations are also distinguished by high levels of sophistication and professional management.

Last year it also ranked as the 13th exporter and 12th importer of services worldwide with a share of 2.3% in both cases.

Belgium boasts an exceptional higher education and training system, with excellent math and science education, top-notch management schools and a strong propensity for on-the-job training. These elements contribute to an overall high capacity to innovate.
